-20 Observations -10 Questions -5 (minutes of) Reflection -1 Application	-Sin to confess -Promise to claim -Example to follow -Command to obey	1) What's this say about God? 2) What's this say about humanity? 3) How can I apply this to my life today? 4) Who can I share this truth with?	-Silence -Scripture -Self-examination -Supplication	Emphasize different word each time to unlock meaning. (Ex: <i>Psalm 23:1</i> ) 1) THE Lord is my shepherd 2) The LORD is my... 3) The Lord IS my... etc
